She also appeared with Karen Clark Sheard in a musical drama, "Sex – The Silent Killer" for which she wrote three musical pieces and she appeared with Composer/Director Robert Ray as a featured soloist in the performance of his world renowned "Gospel Mass." Sue also has her own CD project, "Words Just Cannot Explain"; which features a unique blend of traditional gospel as well as contemporary gospel that allows you to experience her powerful and moving vocals.

In October, 2002 Sue was one of six Regional Tellers who performed at Exchange Place during the National Storytelling Festival in Jonesborough, Tennessee. Sue has a gift for spontaneity, which allows her to fully involve her listeners. Her audiences have included educational assemblies, Scouting Troops, Library Programs, schools, senior citizen gatherings and all types of retreats and conferences. She is committed to the use of story to pave the way for understanding and the reaching of personal goals and
